

MIEM scholarships at Paris Descartes University

1. What is a MIEM scholarship ?

The MIEM scholarship is a tool to increase the attractiveness and the influence of Paris. Students of the University of Paris could increase their academical and professional success because they will be more open to the world.

This scholarship aims at :

- Setting scholarships for a Master 2 level
- Being able to attract foreign students with strong potential which will be able to study in PhD afterwards
- Enabling several training offers to be more visible internationally
- Encouraging the training offers' directors to develop their international potential : curriculum into English, creation of options/fields of study for international students, internationalizing the teaching staff...

3. How to apply for a MIEM scholarship ?

Only the students who apply for one of the selected Masters can send an application for the MIEM scholarship.

- **Required conditions :**

The students will be allowed to send an application only if he/she satisfies the conditions below :

- Be of a foreign nationality
- Be graduated with a foreign high school diploma (equivalent to the French « baccalauréat »)

The application will be admissible only if the student has been accepted in the Master he/she applied in.

The following students cannot participate to the MIEM program :

- The students who were graduated with a French « baccalauréat » and studied abroad
- The foreign students who are graduated from a French bachelor (licence)
- Students with dual nationality

- **Level of access :**

- Master 1 for any student graduated with a foreign bachelor
- Master 2 for any student graduated with a foreign diploma equivalent to a French « Master 1 »

Each Master will apply the general criteria and its own selection criteria.

- **Application procedure :**

- **Step 1 :** the candidate has to get in touch by email with the International Exchange and Program Service (bourses.excellences@parisdescartes.fr) in order to get the application file for the MIEM scholarship.

Your application file must include the following required documents :

- A Curriculum Vitae
- A motivation letter (max. 1 page)
- List of the taken courses
- Transcripts of records of the last three years (current year included)
- Copies of your diplomas
- Certificate of inscription for the current university year
- Copy of the passport
- Certificate of language level

- Letters of recommendation of teachers or researchers - at least, one of the letters has to be written by a member of your home institution (optional)
- **Step 2:** The candidate has to send by email his/her application file (the application file completed and the required documents in PDF) to the International and Exchange Program Service (bourses.excellences@parisdescartes.fr), which will send it to the director of the chosen Master
The object of the mail should mention the following description : « **Application file MIEM scholarship 2019-2020** ».
- **Deadline for application :**

The deadline for application is **April, 20th, 2019.**

4. Selection of the candidates

The directors of the Masters suggest candidates for the MIEM scholarships after they read their application files.

The International Exchange and Programs Service will send the application files of each student – as soon as it receive them – to the director of the concerned Master.
